Election of Reeve at the First Meeting of the Grantham <u>Township Council</u>

According to the Grantham Township Council Minutes of **Monday**, **January 21**st, **1850**, Council met at Mr. Caver's Inn, Ten Mile Creek, pursuant to Statute 12, Victoria, Chapter 81 with the following present:

John Gilleland, John Ker, Walter Ditterick, Robert Lawrie, and John Read. Councillors proceeded with the election of Township Officers. Reeve Mr. John Gilleland was unanimously chosen. It was moved by Mr. Lawrie and seconded by Mr. Read and carried, that Charles Rolls be appointed Clerk. It was moved by Mr. Lawrie and seconded by Mr. Ditterick, and carried, that Charles Rolls be Treasurer. At the same meeting, Reeve Gilleland was empowered to procure a common seal, the same to be a facsimile form with the words "Municipal Council, Township of Grantham" engraved around the border and a sheaf of wheat in the centre thereof.
